NOTICE

Whereas, the Rule 134-A of the Haryana School Education Rules, 2003 amended from time to time mandates that meritorious children belonging to economically weaker sections of the society can receive free of cost education by getting admission in the private schools to the extent of 10% of the total seats available in these schools. Through public notice the Department had asked these schools to declare the availability of seats through online application of the Department on MIS portal. Unless and until the schools truthfully share this information on a public platform the aspirant students cannot transparently know where to apply for their admissions. If a school does not share this information then it is wilfully thwarting the statutory objectives of Rule 134-A. For this deliberate default a school renders itself liable for the regulatory action as prescribed in Rule-43 of the rules mentioned above. Such regulatory action may include withdrawal of Recognition/NOC or disaffiliation, as the case may be. We all are aware that Hon'ble Courts have time and again stressed upon the implementation of the Rule 134 A in true letter and spirit.

And whereas, I am provisionally satisfied that the school which have not provided full and correct information have violated the statutory rules and hence rendered themselves liable for action.

In view of above, through this notice these schools are called upon to show cause as to why the Recognition/NOC granted to them may not be withdrawn for the default/defiance committed by them. Their reply should reach the undersigned explaining therein the reasons for their conduct within a week of the publication of this notice, failing which the orders for withdrawal of the recognition/NOC shall be passed ex-parte.
