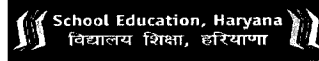

Whereas Yogita Virmani and others working as Art & Craft Teachers in different schools of District Gurgaon had filed the CWP No.6503 of 2015 titled as 'Yogita Virmani and others V/s State of Haryana & others' praying for directing the respondent to consider the appointment of the petitioners from the dates the candidates lower in merit have been appointed, for the purpose of seniority, pay and other benefits.

The writ petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble High Court Punjab & Haryana, Chandigarh on 08.04.2015 and the same was disposed of with the following directions:-

"The present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider the demand notice dated 16.02.2015 at Annexure P-3 and take appropriate decision, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of two months, from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, the claim of the petitioners is accepted, then consequential benefits, if any, be given to the petitioners, within a further period of two months. In case, respondent do not grant any relief then a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioners.

The writ petition is disposed of accordingly."

In pursuance to above orders, the matter has been taken up and perused the Demand Notice dated 16.02.2015 (Annexure P-2).

The facts in brief of the case are that the Haryana Staff Selection Commission vide advertisement No.7/2003 dated 18.10.2003 advertised 664 posts of Art & Craft Teachers and in pursuance of the said advertisement, the petitioners had applied for the said post. The petitioners were selected and the candidates lower in merit to petitioners had joined their duties in the months of August & September, 2004 and the appointment of petitioners was withheld on the ground that they have passed their Art & Craft Diploma from Board of Technical Education, Govt. of Delhi as it was not recognised by the State Govt.

Aggrieved against the abovesaid action, petitioners filed CWP No.18060 of 2004 titled as 'Balram Kaushik and others vs. State of Haryana etc.'. The said writ petition was



disposed of on 16.09.2005 in terms of the Division Bench judgement of Hon'ble High Court rendered in CWP No.4391 of 2004 titled as "Nek Singh and others V/s State of Haryana etc."

In compliance of the Hon'ble High Court orders, the petitioners were appointed as Art & Craft teacher and they joined their duties on 10.05.2006, 10.05.2006, 12.05.2006 and 10.05.2006 respectively.

It is relevant to mention here that the service conditions of Art & Craft teachers are governed by statutory Rules called Haryana State Education School Cadre (Group C) Service Rules, 1998. The Rule 11 which deals with seniority is reproduced below for ready reference :

"11. Seniority- Seniority, inter se of the members of the Service, shall be determined by the length of continuous Service on any post in the Service:

Provided further that in the case of a member appointed by direct recruitment, the order of merit determined by the Commission or any other recruiting authority as the case may be, shall not be disturbed in fixing the seniority:

Provided further that in case of two or more members appointed on the same date, their seniority shall be determined as follows:

- a) a member appointed by direct recruitment shall be senior to a member appointed by promotion or by transfer;*
- b) a member appointed by promotion shall be senior to a member appointed by transfer;*
- c) in the case of a member appointed by promotion or by transfer, seniority shall be determined according to the seniority of such members in the appointment from which they are promoted or transferred; and*
- d) in the case of members appointed by transfer from different cadres, their seniority shall be determined according to pay, preference being given to a member, who was drawing a higher rate of pay in his previous appointment, and if the rates of pay drawn are also the same, then by the length of their Service in the appointments and if the length of such service is also same, the older member shall be senior to the younger member".*

The petitioners were higher in merit and candidates selected in the same list and lower in merit to the petitioners had been appointed in the year 2004 and the



petitioners were offered appointment in the year 2006 and they joined on 10.5.2006 & 12.5.2006. The detail of the petitioners and their juniors of District Gurgaon as shown in the Demand Notice is given below for ready reference:-

That Hon'ble High Court in civil writ petition No. 5956 of 2008 titled as Charan Dass Vs. State of Haryana decided on 18.11.2008 wherein it has been held that seniors are entitled to fix their pay at par with their juniors. It has also been settled by the Hon'ble High Court in a judgment reported as 2009 (2) SCT 488 titled as Darshan Kaur Vs. State of Punjab that seniors are entitled to be appointed from the dates their juniors have been appointed. The relevant observations of the Hon'ble High Court are as under:-

"This petition is accordingly allowed. The respondents are directed to issue appointment letter to the petitioner within one month from the date of receipt of


certified copy of this order. It is also directed that the petitioner shall be entitled to seniority on the basis of her merit in the selection, though she will not be entitled to any monetary benefits for the period she has been deprived of the appointment, although her salary shall be fixed on appointment giving her notional benefit of seniority increments, pay revision, if any etc."

As per the above chart and perusal of the Selection List reveals that the petitioners are higher in merit in comparison to the other candidates who have been selected in the same list and appointed. Although the petitioners were having the Diploma of Art & Craft Teacher, but from Delhi and because of that their appointments was withheld and ultimately the petitioners were offered appointments and joined on 10.05.2006 & 12.5.2006, but the candidates lower in merit to the petitioners have been offered appointments in the month of August/September 2004 and they joined their duties at that time.

The prayer of the petitioners in Demand Notice is that the candidates lower in merit to the petitioners have been appointed in the month of August/September 2004 and the petitioners were offered appointment and joined on 10.5.2006 & 12.5.2006. It has also been stated that the juniors to them are getting the benefit of two increments more in comparison to the petitioners every month. Apart from that all employees of the Haryana State who were appointed prior to 31.12.2005 were governed by old Pension Scheme while who were appointed after 1.1.2006 are governed by new Pension Scheme and the old Pension Scheme is more beneficial in comparison to new Pension Scheme.

Now, the petitioners have demanded for according them the deemed date appointment from the dates the juniors to them have been appointed. In this regard, as per the chart shown by the petitioners in the Demand Notice, the immediate junior in merit from all the petitioners, who joined his duties at the earliest is 12.08.2004 namely Sh.Sombir bearing Merit No.363. So the deemed date of appointment of all the petitioners is being considered as 12.08.2004 instead of 10.5.2006 & 12.5.2006.

In view of above mentioned facts, the relevant record of the case and keeping in view the rulings on the issue, I am of the view that the claim of the petitioners is justified



and deserves to be accepted.

Therefore, the petitioners namely Yogita Virmani etc. , Art & Craft Teachers, are hereby granted the benefit of deemed date appointment w.e.f. the date as mentioned below against their names only for the purpose of notionally benefits i.e. pay fixation and seniority only. **It is made clear that no arrear will be payable to them from the dates of their deemed date of the appointment to actual date of joining into the service because they did not actually work during the said period.** The decision regarding PPF/GPF will be taken by the Accountant General, Haryana thereof.
