

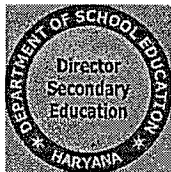

Whereas Smt. Prem Bai & five others filed CWP No.8743 of 2017 before Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court praying therein for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the petitioner benefit of ACP Pay scales on completion of 8/16/24 years regular satisfactory service instead of 10/20/30 years regular satisfactory service. The writ petition came for hearing before Hon'ble Court on 27.04.2017. After hearing the case, the Hon'ble Court pleased to direct the official respondents to pass a speaking order relating to whether the petitioners are entitled for grant of ACP or not?

The claims of the petitioners have been considered and found that all the petitioners have already been granted due benefits of ACP Pay scales on completion of required length of regular satisfactory service as required under Haryana Civil Services (ACP) Pay Scales Rules 1998/2008 and as amended by Finance Department Haryana vide order dated 04.03.2014. The detail of granted benefits is as under:-

used That the F.D latter dated 4.03.2014 has already been challenged in CWP No. 17496 of 2014- Om Parkash and Others vs. State of Haryana and Others decided on 18.03.2017 with a bunch of 74 other writ petitions calming that the same would be applicable retrospectively. The Hon'ble High Court decided these writ petitions vide judgment dated 18.03.2017 and held that the petitioner are not entitled for any benefit retrospectively. **The operative part of the judgment is reproduced as under:-**

"The persons who are in service prior to 04.03.2014, the benefit of order dated 04.03.2014 is applicable to the extent that grant of ACP to those who have completed 8, 16 and 24 years of service, the same cannot be denied prospectively i.e. after 04.03.2014. Having regards to the fact that 04.03.2014 order is not substitution to the 2008 Rules as is evident from the fact that on 04.03.2014 certain modified ACP Grade Pay in respect of category I and II was incorrect. In order to rectify the same, the official respondents' have proceeded to pass a fresh order on 04.03.2014 with reference to cited note (Supra). In that context the word "(to be substituted bearing with same number and dated)" has been indicated. In other words it does not mean that substitution of the 2008 Rules. It is only substitution of 04.03.2014 order to the extent of rectifying the category I and

2 and modified ACP Grade Pay from 10650-10800-2000 (1st 2nd and 3rd ACP) to 1800-1900-2000 (1st 2nd and 3rd ACP), respectively. In view of these factual and legal aspect the petitioners are not entitled for any benefit retrospectively, In other words intervening period from 01.01.2006 to 04.03.2014 is applicable to only those who are in service as on 04.03.2014 and not for those who have retired from service prior to 04.03.2014”.

Perusing all statutory financial rules i.e. ACP rules 1998/2008/2016, it is evident itself that prior to order dated 04.03.2014, the benefit of ACP Pay scales was grantable only on completion of 10/20/30 years regular satisfactory service and after order dated 04.03.2014, the time period has been reduced to 8/16/24 years regular satisfactory service. The present claim of the petitioners is a result of their own conjectures and surmises, therefore, wrong and denied. Moreover on completion of required regular satisfactory service, the due ACP benefits (supra) have been granted to petitioners as admitted by them in para 2 of the writ petition. The petitioners are not entitled to get the benefit of ACP on completion 08/16/24 years retrospectively. Hence their claim is hereby rejected.

I pass order accordingly.
