Whereas, Premraj Sharma & Others filed CWP No. 7587 of 2018 titled as Premraj Versus State of Haryana & Others Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court which was disposed of vide order dated 27.03.2018 with the following orders

**"Mr. RK Doon, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies furnished.**

**For the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statements/counter affidavits on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.**

**The petitioners pray for a direction to the respondents to fix their pay at par with their juniors and with effect from the date the anomaly had crept in i.e. 01.01.1996. The petitioners purport to have repeatedly represented to the respondents in this regard, but to no avail. Even, the legal notice dated 01.02.2018 (Annexure P4), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response.**

**In response, learned State counsel submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioners, as also their legal notice dated 01.02.2018 (Annexure P4), shall be considered and dealt with within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.**

**The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.**

**However, in the event the claim of the petitioners is declined, the respondent-authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof."**

In compliance of above mentioned order, the legal notice dated 01.02.2018 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners has been examined. In the legal notice the petitioners prayed, that their pay be fixed at par with their junior Sh. Ramdev, Elementary School Head Master, w.e.f.01.01.1996 when the petitioners were working as Skt. Teacher as detailed below:-

It is stated that the post of C&V Skt./ Teacher is Distt. Cadre post and the seniority is maintained at Distt. Level by the concerned District Elementary Education Officer. Sh. Ramdev was working in Distt. Sirsa in the year 1996. While none of the petitioners remain posted in Distt. Sirsa therefore, they could not compare their seniority with the post of other Distt. Cadre post, Sh. Ramdev is admittedly junior to the petitioners as Elementary School Head Master being state cadre post. The service book of Sh. Ram Dev was examined and it has been found, that he was wrongly given the benefit of the one increment while fixing his pay in the 5<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission. Accordingly the pay of Sh. Ramdev, Skt. Teacher presently working as Elementary School Head Master, GSSS Madhosinghana Distt. Sirsa has been refixed w.e.f. 01.01.1996 on implementation of 5<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission in accordance with pay fixation Rules 1998, 2008 and 2016 vide DEEO Sirsa memo No.E/4-18/3059-67 dated 22.11.2018 and the recovery of excess payment will be done and for that show cause notice dated 27.11.2018 has been issued to Sh. Ramdev by the District Elementary Education Officer, Sirsa. Now in brief the pay fixation of Sh. Ramdev will be as under:-

The petitioner are already getting similar pay fixation as mentioned above. That since, the pay of Sh. Ramdev who is admittedly junior to the petitioners as

Elementary School Head Master has been rectified as mentioned above and the pay of the petitioners is at par, hence no step up case of the petitioners is made out.

In view of the above claim made in the legal notice dated 01.02.2018 (Annexure P-4) has no merit which is liable to be rejected.
