Whereas a complaint dated 16.03.2016 against Sh. Rishi Kumar, DPE, Govt. Senior Secondary School Meghot Hala, Mahendergarh now at GSSS Akbarpur, Mahendergarh was received from DEEO Narnaul and on the basis of which he has been served a chargesheet under Rule-7 of HCS (Punishment & Appeal) Rules, 2016 vide order dated 17.11.2016. Thereafter, Sh. Balwan Singh, IAS (Retd.) has been appointed Inquiry Officer. He reported on 01.06.2017 observing therein that the charges leveled upon the delinquent stand proved. The enquiry report has duly been served upon him as per rule. The delinquent refuted the enquiry report stating and requested for dropping of charge sheet.

On careful consideration of contents on file, enquiry report and the defence submitted by the delinquent, a Show Cause Notice has been served upon the delinquent as to why the penalty of stoppage of two annual increment with cumulative effect be not imposed upon him.

However, before taking such an action, the delinquent was given an opportunity of any representation which he may like to submit in this connection. The delinquent submitted his representation dated 25.06.2018 and an opportunity of personal hearing granted to him on 14.09.2018.

The delinquent heard in person during personal hearing on 14.09.2018 but he failed to refute the charges leveled against him in the charge sheet. Still a lenient view has been taken and the punishment of stoppage of one increment without cumulative effect is imposed upon Sh. Rishi Kumar, DPE.

**Dated Panchkula, the 14.09.2018**

Whereas a complaint dated 19.01.2016 against Sh. Mohd. Idrish, SS Master, Govt. High School Gangoli, Mewat now GMS Rojka Meo (Nuh) was received from DEEO Mewat and on the basis of which he has been suspended vide order dated 27.04.2016 and served a chargesheet under Rule-7 of HCS (Punishment & Appeal) Rules, 1987 vide order dated 31.07.2017. Thereafter, Sh. R.P. Bhasin, District & Session Judge (Retd.) has been appointed Inquiry Officer. He reported on 13.04.2018 observing therein that the charges leveled upon the delinquent stand proved as delinquent absent from duty willfully and without approval of the competent authority. The enquiry report has duly been served upon him as per rule. The delinquent refuted the enquiry report stating that the enquiry report has been completed by declaring him exparte . He requested for dropping of charge sheet.

He made written submissions in his defence reply but failed to submit concrete proof in his defense. Considering all the facts of the matter, I am satisfied with the report of Inquiry Officer. I am of the considered view that the delinquent deserves to be punished, accordingly, a Show Cause Notice under the principles of natural justice to award a punishment of stoppage of one increment with cumulative effect upon the delinquent has been issued. However, he has been granted an opportunity to reply the Show Cause Notice within 15 days.

The delinquent submitted his representation dated 25.07.2018 and an opportunity of personal hearing granted to him on 14.09.2018.

The delinquent heard in person during personal hearing on 14.09.2018 but he failed to refute the charges leveled against him in the charge sheet. Still a lenient view has been taken and the punishment of stoppage of one increment without cumulative effect is imposed upon Sh. Mohd. Idrish, SS Master and suspension period be treated as leave of kind due.
