Whereas Sh. Purshotam Lal (Retd.), SS Master has filed regular second appeal i.e. RSA No. 5751 of 2014 – Purshotam Lal praying therein that he is entitled to first Assured Career Progression Pay Scale after taking into account the service rendered by him on sanction post in a Aided School w.e.f. 01.04.1983 till the school is taken over i.e. 26.03.1990. The RSA came for hearing before Hon'ble High Court on 15.02.2018 after considering the provisions of para 5 to 7 of letter dated 10.06.2011 issued by the Secondary Education Department the Hon'ble High Court disposed of the RSA with following directions:-

“Insofar as extending the pensionary benefits are concerned, concerned respondents are hereby directed to consider the appellant's case with reference to instructions dated 10.06.2011. In this regard, appellant is directed to make appropriate representation within a period of four weeks from today. Concerned respondent is hereby directed to consider appellant's grievance relating to counting of service from 1.4.1983 the date on which the school was declared as aided institute till retirement of the appellant on 31.12.2009 towards grant of retiral benefits and pass a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of appellant's application or representation. Accordingly, trial and appellate court decisions are modified.”

In compliance of this order the appellant namely Purshotam Lal submitted a detailed representation dated 07.03.2018 which received in this Directorate on 21.03.2018. Thereafter, the representation has been considered in detail in the light of the service book of the appellant itself. It has been found that the appellant appointed as Head Master at Vidya Deep Middle School Kainthal Khurd (Karnal) vide order dated 12.04.1979. Further vide District Education Office, Karnal order no. G-1/83/614-621 dated 11.11.1983 the said school was granted permanent recognition w.e.f. 01.04.1983. Thereafter, vide Director School Education Haryana Chandigarh order dated 13.11.1986, a post of master cadre was sanctioned in this school thereafter vide management vide order no. 10 dated 21.12.1986 the appellant was appointed on sanctioned post of SS Master, Hence, the claim of the petitioner to count his service w.e.f. 01.04.1983 to 20.12.1986 is not maintainable as he never served upon on a sanction post, moreover, the service of the appellant from 21.12.1986 to till the date of his superannuation i.e. 31.12.2009 = 23 years 10 days has been counted towards pensionary benefits. As per order dated 10.06.2011, issued by the Directorate of School Education Haryana, Panchkula, the service rendered on a sanctioned post of a Govt. Aided School, either before the school is taken over or the teacher joined govt. service is countable towards pension only if, the concerned teacher/ master deposits employer share of Contributed Provident Fund (CPF) with compound interest @ 10 % per annum thereon in government treasury. The department made this calculation which is verified Rs. 53725/- by Section Officer O/o DEEO Kurukshetra but the appellant concealed this fact that he has never deposited this amount in govt. treasury till date. Hence, this amount is recoverable from him since the appellant has been granted pension after taking into account the service rendered by him on sanctioned post i.e. 21.12.1986 to 25.03.1990.

Whereas the benefit of ACP is concerned it is matter of fact that before the date of taken over of school w.e.f. 26.03.1990, the appellant was an employee of School Management Vidya Deep Middle School Kainthal Khurd (Karnal). During this period he cannot be considered as a Haryana Govt. employee. The provisions of Note-2 of Rule 1.8 of Punjab CSR Vol.1 Part 1 define the term State Govt. Employee as under:-


“The expression “State Government employees,” means all persons whose conditions of service may be regulated by rules made by the Governor of Haryana under the provision to Article 309 of the Constitution.”

Since the service of the appellant w.e.f. 21.12.1986 to 25.03.1990 i.e. 3 years 3 months 4 days is not a service under provisions of Rules framed under Article 309 of the Constitution of India, therefore, the appellant cannot be considered as State Govt. employee, whereas, the Haryana Civil Services (ACP) Rules, 1998 are applicable on State Govt. employee only. As per Rule 2(1) of ACP Rules, 1998, the benefit of ACP Pay scale is grantable to persons appointed to civil services and posts in connection with the affairs of the Government of Haryana and who are under the administrative control of the Government of Haryana and whose pay is debitable to the Consolidated Fund of the State of Haryana. It is matter of fact that the Govt. of Haryana School Education Department reimburses only 75 % of the expenditure occurred on imparting education through sanctioned posts only, therefore, the reimbursement cannot be termed as pay from consolidated fund of the State. On this ground also, the service rendered by the appellant from 21.12.1986 to 25.03.1990 is not countable as Govt. service. Hence, the appellant has been found ineligible to count this service towards ACP benefits. It is also worthwhile to submit that a judgment in a writ, is a judgment in personam, consequently, such judgment cannot be used as a judgment in a rem.

Considering all the facts and circumstances of this case with representation, it has been found that the appellant has enjoyed the pensionary benefits of the service he rendered on the sanctioned post i.e. 21.12.1986 to 25.03.1990 without depositing/refunding the calculated amount of Rs. 53725/-, therefore, this amount deserves to be recovered from the appellant, consequently, he is advised to deposit/refund the same in govt. treasury at the earliest, i.e. within a months period otherwise legal process would be initiated against him as per rule. As per service book, the appellant has already been granted benefit of 1st Assured Career Progression Pay Scale w.e.f. 01.04.2000, on completion of 10 years regular satisfactory service and before completing the 20 years of service, the appellant achieved the age of superannuation i.e. 58 years, in December 2009, he cannot be granted benefit of 2nd ACP Pay Scale.

The claims of the appellant have been considered from all angles but he is not found entitled for the same under the rules. Moreover, an amount of Rs. 53725/- has been found recoverable from him, if not earlier deposited/refunded as no endorsement of such deposit/refund has been found in the service book. Finally, the representation dated 07.03.2018 has been found devoid of merits, consequently, the claimed benefits are hereby declined.

Ordered accordingly.
