Sir/Madam,


I am directed to refer to the subject mentioned above, and to inform that as per judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 06.12.2007 in case of Election Commission of India in SLP No. 2963 of 2004, Election Commission of India Vs St. Marry's School and Others, it has been held that:

"We, therefore, direct that all teaching staff shall be put on the duties of roll revisions and election works on holidays and non-teaching days. Teachers should not ordinarily be put on duty on teaching days and within teaching hours."

2. The Government of India has further issued guidelines under Section 35 of the RTE Act-2009 vide their letter No. F. No. 1-3/2010-EE-4, dated 13.09.2010.

3. It is, therefore, requested that the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court may be complied with strictly.
